

I am a missionary priest. My work has been in different places round the world. In my early days I was a teacher in Liverpool. I was Provincial of our Order a long time ago and that brought me round the world to all our missions. After that I worked in retreat work and adult education in faith in Galway. I am now helping young students as they begin their way to the priesthood.

A FAITH READING GROUP

We are very blessed in our country in our schools and the high level of education people now reach. We are the envy of much of the world. Sadly, our level of education in our faith does not keep up with the other subjects and sometimes our faith education is little above infant level. This leaves our faith open to ridicule and probably accounts for many leaving their faith. It is also a great impoverishment of our lives because our Christian faith has such a deep and beautiful knowledge in it. Faith is more than knowledge but if we don't know our faith well, we lose a lot.

Over the years, I have started groups who come together to study their faith. We pick a spiritual book, read a chapter each week (or each month) and come and share about it. Gradually, we find we have grown in knowing our faith and feel challenged in a new way to live it with people in a deeper Christian way.
