Firstly, I would like thank all those who lead our service every Thursday at 10am. These are women and men from our faith community who have with dignity and prayerful attention ensured that every Thursday there is a prayer gathering in our church.

We know that after Jesus had died, risen, and ascended into heaven that the disciples remained fearful and confused. However, after Pentecost they took their mission as Jesus had wanted, and they began to proclaim the good news of the kingdom.

Central to their mission was prayer with the community, led by women and men, and we hear that in the description of the first church as it began in the Acts of the Apostles:

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favour of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved. (Acts 2: 42-47)

Our service each Thursday organised and offered within this context and where possible I invite you to support it and our faith community.
