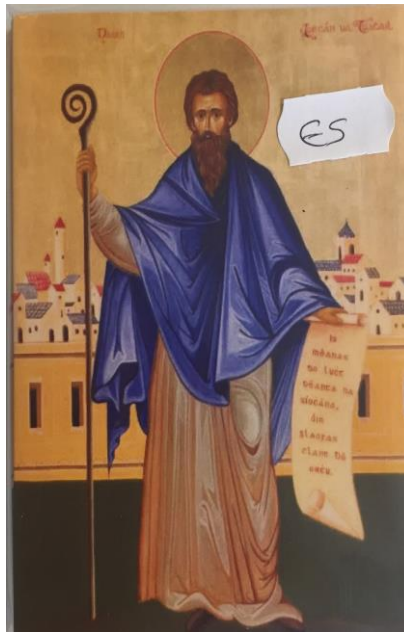

**SUNDAY INTRODUCTIONS**

**First reading Is 8:23-9:3 (9:1-4)**

Our Gospel reading quotes part of this passage. It was written at a time of false economic growth and real international pressure. In the face of these, the prophet does offer hope—but as the gift of God alone.

**Second reading 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17**

In the light of the week of prayer for Christian unity, this reading should speak to us all. Conflict, even with Christianity, is normal. The question is whether it should lead to division or rather a deeper communion in Christ.

**Gospel Matthew 4:12-23**

Although we have been reading Matthew since the start of Advent, today we begin reading the Gospel continuously from the start of Jesus’ ministry. The ministry begins with a ringing proclamation of the Kingdom, a proclamation which lays the foundations for all that follows.
