Pope Francis will travel to Dublin in August to attend the World Meeting of Families

The Pope will arrive in Dublin on **Saturday, 25 August**, and will take part in the 'Festival of Families' in **Croke Park Stadium** - **This is a free event**

On **Sunday 26 August**, he will preside at **Holy Mass in the Phoenix Park** which will close the five day event - **this is also a free event**

Tickets are required for access to all events - even the free events at Croke Park and Phoenix Park.

There is a fee for tickets to the Congress on Wed 22nd- Fri 24th August - Registration is now open.

There is the option for Single day or full 3 day tickets - both include a Guaranteed option to book a free ticket for Festival of Families + the Final Mass

Free Access tickets for Festival of Families (Croke Park) ONLY and the Final Mass (Phoenix Park) ONLY - **not yet available.**
