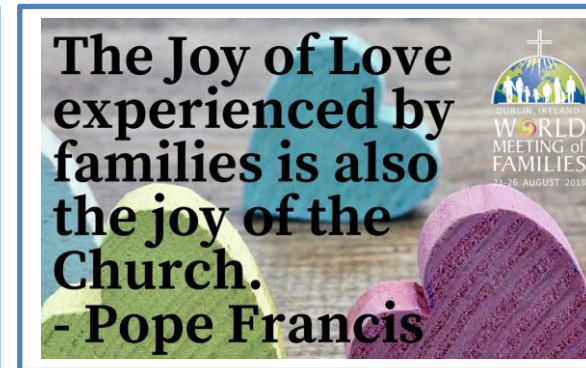
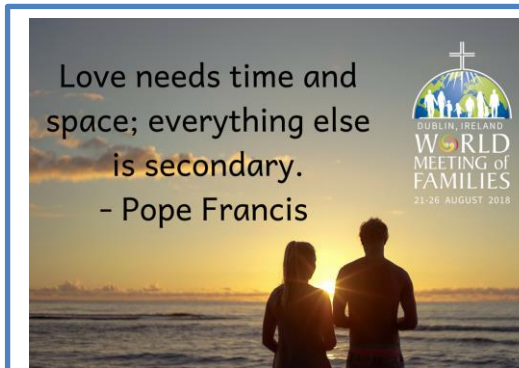
**World Meeting of Families 2018**
