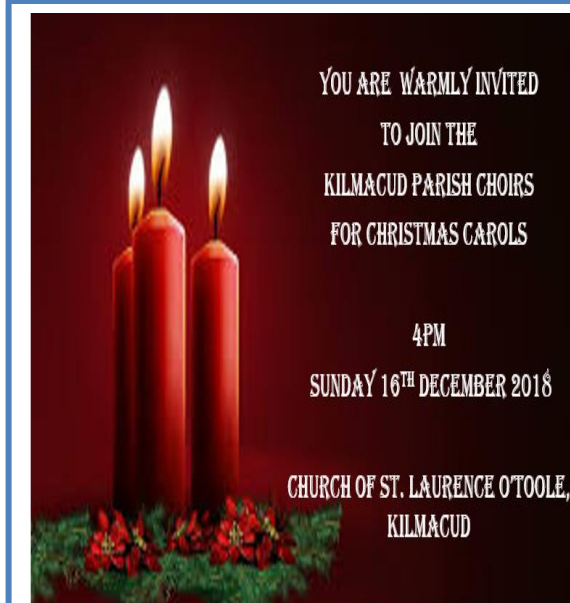

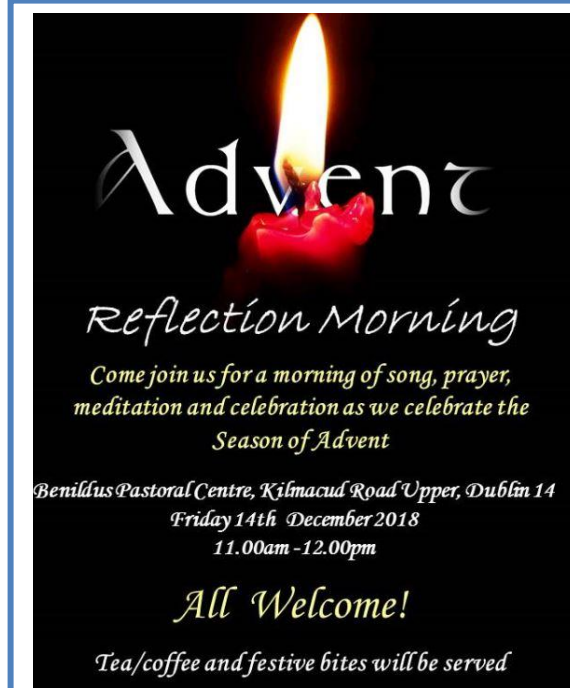
Obelisk
